

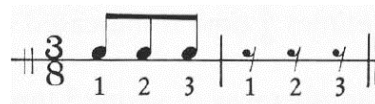

### MORE TIME SIGNATURES

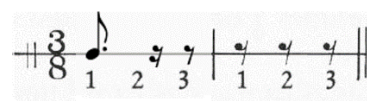


means three beats/counts in each bar.  
means an eighth note gets one beat/count.

In a 3/8-time signature, an eighth note or rest receives one beat/count.

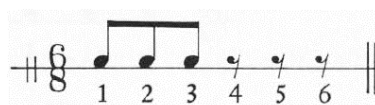


A dotted eighth note or rest will receive one and a half beats/counts.

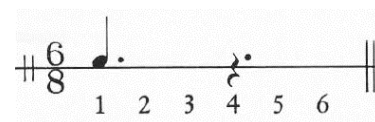


means six beats/counts in each bar.  
means an eighth note gets one beat/count.

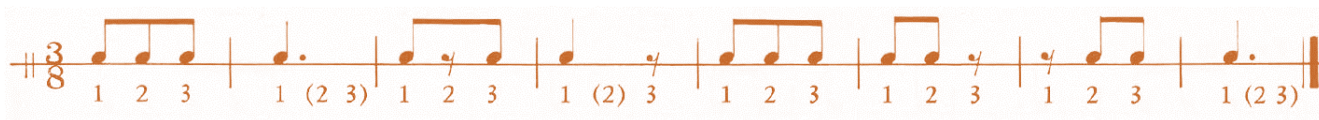
In a 6/8-time signature an eighth note or rest receives one beat/count.



A dotted quarter note or rest will receive three beats/counts.



1. Count the beats and clap the rhythm of the notes and rests.



2. Write the counts under the notes. Remember that there are six beats in every bar/measure. Count the beats and clap the rhythm.



3. Fill in the missing beats with notes or rests and clap the rhythm.
